

EDITORIAL

LIFE AS YOU KNOW IT?

The early months of 2011 have been full of news about fresh planetary discoveries using the wonderful high-tech telescopes now at our disposal situated beyond the Earth's atmosphere. Of course all of these planets (if they are) are many light years away and any life there would need to be extremely advanced to make contact with us here on Earth. One assessment of these 500 or so "planets" is that they are too large, too small, too hot or too cold to have any chance of sustaining life as we know it. But even on Earth, life has evolved in extremes of temperature and pressure at the polar icecaps or miles down at the bottom of the oceans, where we, the most advanced life on the planet would perish within seconds without special protective clothing or inside pressurised submersibles.

One scientist thinks he has found fossilised remains of forms of bacteria inside meteorites arriving from deep space. This is not unduly surprising as it is an indication of how life of Earth developed from simple cell structures such as bacteria, and this went on for a couple of billion years before anything more advanced emerged. We are confidently told that the Earth is 4½ billion years old and if this was scaled down to a 24 hour clock the human existence would measure just 5 seconds before mid-night! It might be more convenient to stick to the creationist line that the whole thing kicked off in 4004 BC!

Whatever one's beliefs, the biggest mystery remains why the huge surge in human creativity and intelligence which has only emerged in the past 5,000 years or so, going back to civilisations in Egypt, Mesopotania, China and parts of North and South America. In fact a monumental leap forward which completely eclipses anything gone before has emerged during the last 100 years alone. While humans race ahead, fellow dwellers such as chimpanzees, dogs, cats plus whales and dolphins in the oceans do nothing else but recycle themselves over and over again, showing little signs of any intellectual advancement. Even chimps and dolphins taught tricks by people would take a million years to write a novel in my view, and as for building a car with an internal combustion engine ---- All other life except ours is preprogrammed to subconsciously go forth and multiply within their own eco systems but nothing outside the prime function.

The dynosaurs were the controlling life forms from 250 millions to 65 millions years ago, but despite their immense size and weight (some considered to be 100ft long and weigh 100 tons) believed to be caused by much higher levels of oxygen in the atmosphere at the timeall that remains of this long legacy is bones, teeth and petrified eggs. Some smaller species such as the crocodile are believed to have originated in this period, but the only intelligence shown is the ability to hunt down and kill prey in a unique fashion. Living partly in water and partly on land has maybe ensured the survival of this reptile over periods of trauma on the planet.

If on other planets life is evolving in a similar way to Earth, maybe there are dynosaur like creatures roaming, but with no awareness of life on other worlds. Could any of them have experienced the "5 seconds before midnight" moment? Comparing our own planet with the 7 others surveyed with their moons in our local backyard, the Solar System, all emerge as barren, inhospitable places with deeply cratered surfaces or consist of masses of unstable gas. Any form of life on these would have to evolve by entirely different means to ours. Earth with its vibrant colours and atmosphere looks entirely out of place with its neighbours.

Were odds of billions to one needed to kick start life here in the first place and similar odds needed to create the intelligence that separates the human species from the rest?

One explanation is that the human race was planted on this planet by superior beings as an experiment. These 'Masters of the Universe' occasionally return to check on progress hence UFO reports. My own theory is that humans have changed 'spiritually' from being mainly sub-conscious mind to almost fully conscious mind - man can decide on almost all aspects of how he goes about his existence, other than the primary bodily functions which are automatically triggered. At some stage energy circulating around the body was diverted to certain parts of the brain which is the centre of creative intelligence. At the same time instinctual abilities were lost. Our ancestors from the Neolithic period onwards could sense positive and negative energy leylines subconsciously and built settlements and buried their dead at certain positive locations - something modern man can only detect by dowsing. Similarly today, man seems to have a lesser sense of smell and evesight compared to a number of contemporary animals and birds. A change in the flow of chi, the life force, around the body caused by a physical blockage somewhere as part of the evolutionary process, may have brought this massive change about, although this can never be proved scientifically. Physical changes to human anatomy may occur over many generations, such as the cleft at the base of the spine where it is believed a tail once may have existed, and the troublesome appendix organ which is still there but serves no known function.

We can already see rapid upward changes in human size and longevity particularly in well fed western nations. Teenagers in 2011 appear to be about 3 inches taller on average from those of 50 years before or 6 inches taller going back 100 years. However mental illness and cancers seem to be on the increase possibly indicating that the supercharged body is not well subconsciously.

UFO reporting for the start of 2011 seems somewhat muted, but strange things are happening with the discovery of mass suicides or destruction of flocks of birds, fish and other creatures. A dossier of these events has been prepared overleaf, but there is no known reason and the most likely scenario is scaremongering by the media.

A sudden massive uprising by oppressed Arab peoples has led to the removal of dictators in Tunisia and Egypt after 20 years and 30 years respectively, and an on-going situation in Libya which has unfortunately descended into civil war. Other territories are showing signs of unrest which are being clamped down on by the military. Just what sparked off all this revolutionary fervour is a mystery, but increased solar activity recently may have some effect on the mindset of usually compliant citizens in these countries, in the same way that UFO sightings are affected by the sunspot cycles.

LATEST NEWS STORIES

MASS WILDLIFE DEATHS: The early days of 2011 were dominated by stories in the press of huge flocks of birds and shoals of fish or crabs being found dead in various places as far apart as New Zealand, USA and Sweden. Most instances refer to the deaths of distinct single species and are not a random assortment of all types. Fortunately the destruction does not appear to have spread to larger mammals.

The following mysterious deaths have been reported:

- (1) 85.000 carnivorous drum fish washed up along a 17 mile stretch of the Arkansas river, USA
- (2) Up to 5,000 red-winged blackbirds started to rain down on the small town of Beake, Arkansas, USA over a half mile stretch on New Years Eve. Scientists stated they blamed high altitude hail or lightning as they had died from 'multiple blunt force trauma'. Fireworks were also raised as a possible cause, although these would be let off every year at the same time with no previous ill effects.
- (3) Two million dead fish found washed up on the shore of Chesapeake Bay, Maryland, USA.
- (4) More fish found in a creek at Fort Orange, Florida, USA.
- (5) 500 dead birds found along a highway in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, USA.
- (6) More than 1,000 dead turtle doves rained down on the town of Faenza, Northern Italy.
- (7) At Falkoeping, Sweden, 50 jackdaws crashed to the street.
- (8) At Coromandel, New Zealand, thousands of red snapper fish were washed ashore.
- (9) 150 tons of red tilapia fish found on beaches in Vietnam.
- (10) 100 tons of fish washed up along the Brazilian coast, affecting the local economy.
- (11) 40,000 dead 'devil crabs' washed up on Thanet beaches, Kent, England.

All these events occurred in late December - early January 2011, so does this point to something hostile in the atmosphere is leading to total wipe-out? Suggestions range from death rays to a shift in the magnetic poles of the Earth or UFOs close by. In point of fact the events may be not much more than natural variations, but newsgathering methods with the Internet are now so efficient that every possible source of bird/fish multi-deaths will be located within a few hours anywhere on the planet if a report has been logged. In fact the United States Geographical Society recorded 95 mass wild life deaths in the past 8 months and claim an average of 163 events of this kind every year. Few other reports have emerged since this 'mass hysteria' outbreak in early January. Searching through our files has revealed earlier cases from newsclippings to hand.

NASA COMMENT! The space administration's reluctance in the past to comment on the fake Moon landings debate plus other situations involving UFOs being removed in their vehicles, has lead to cries of 'cover-up', but there now appears to be a level of communication with the public on popular topics.

It is pretty obvious that the science in this film is totally absurd starting with the claim that neutrino particles are heating up the Earth's core. NASA points out that neutrinos are neutral particles and do not interact with physical substances. Despite the nonsense portrayed, this Roland Emmerich creation has grossed £640 million at the box-office and DVD sales. Clever directors latch on to fears and aspirations seen on Internet sites and weld together an all embracing tale with the help of vast technical resources and money!

On the other hand NASA praises the 1997 film 'GATTACA' as being the most realistic in the use of science - featuring Ethan Hawke and Una Thurman, the plot involves a genetically inferior man who assumes the identity of a superior one to pursue his dream of space travel. In second place is the UFO film 'CONTACT' starring Jodie Foster as a scientist who searches for extra-terrestrial life using telescopes.

Looking through the NASA website it now looks as if they are prepared to discuss certain topical issues in a clear and concise fashion. For instance their views on the world ending on Dec 21st, 2012, are set out in the Q and A format below. (Nice to be reassured!)

- (Q) Are there any threats to the Earth in 2012? Many internet websites say the world will end in 2012.
- (A) Nothing bad will happen to the Earth in 2012. Our planet has been getting along just fine for more than 4 billion years, and credible scientists worldwide know of no threat associated with 2012.
- (Q) What is the origin of the prediction that the world will end in 2012?
- (A) The story started with claims that Nibiru, a supposed planet discovered by the Sumerians, is headed towards Earth. This catastrophe was initially predicted for May 2003, but when nothing happened the doomsday date was moved forward to December 2012. Then these two fables were linked to the end of one of the cycles of the ancient Mayan calendar at the winter solstice in 2012 hence the predicted doomsday date of December 21st, 2012.

- (Q) Does the Mayan calendar end in December 2012?
- (A) Just as the calendar on your kitchen wall does not cease to exist after December 31st, the Mayan calendar does not cease to exist on December 21, 2012. This date is the end of the Mayan long-count period but then just as your calendar begins again on January 1st another long-count begins for the Mayan calendar.
- (Q) Could a phenomena occur where planets align in a way that impacts Earth?
- (A) There are no planetary alignments in the next few decades. Earth will cross the Galactic plane in 2012, and even if these alignments were to occur, their effects on the Earth would be negligible. Each December the Earth and Sun align with the approximate centre of the Milky Way Galaxy but that is an annual event of no consequence.
- (Q) How do NASA scientists feel about claims of pending doomsday?
- (A) For any claims of disaster or dramatic changes in 2012, where is the science? Where is the evidence? There is none, and for all the fictional assertions, whether they are made in books, movies or documentaries or over the Internet, we cannot change that simple fact. There is no credible evidence for any of the assertions made in support of unusual events taking place in December 2012.

MORE MOD FILES RELEASED: The seventh batch of UFO files have been released to the National Archive in early March 2011. These consist of 35 massive collections containing 8,500 pages. Downloading on the Internet is free for a month. It now appears that the inclusion of parliamentary questions on defence related topics has bulked out the size of the files - each of these needing about 10 pages of bureaucratic detail. Questions from former Admiral of the Fleet and UFO enthusiast, Lord Hill-Norton, look to take up nearly half a file of space alone.

Picking out useful material from the mountains of dross is a painstaking task, but the archive adviser, Dr David Clarke, of Sheffield Hallam University has again done a very good job.

We have printed out detail about RAF Rudloe Manor, which was believed for many years to be a centre for UFO investigation - The British equivalent to 'Area 51'. This came up as a parliamentary question in the Commons in 1998. Also detail of one of the greatest UFO hoaxes of all time has come out with these files, wherein a group of students from Farnborough, Royal Aircraft Establishment made 6 model sized flying saucers and left them at various sites across southern England on September 4th, 1967. This hoax is described in detail below.

THE GREAT 1967 UFO HOAX: As mentioned above the latest release of Ministry of Defence files goes into some detail of an outrageous student prank in which 6 small 'saucers' or 'fried eggs' were constructed and left at certain locations across the south of England to be found by members of the public. This hoax - certainly the most effective carried out in England - fooled the police and the MOD for several hours until the students' cover was blown late in the day of September 4th, 1967. At the time there were high numbers of UFOs being reported generally and with the fear of Soviet secret weapons at the height of the 'Cold War' so the discoveries were checked out with all due diligence including radar records for the previous night which reported negative.

The hoax was initiated at a meeting of Farnborough, Royal Aircraft Establishment trainee engineers, rag committee, in January 1967. The prank was created mainly to raise money for charity as part of the college's Rag Week, but the students, as part of the MOD set up were also interested in seeing how the authorities would react if there was an alien invasion and just how prepared Britain was.

The students went ahead building 6 saucers moulded from fibreglass which were 54ins long, 30ins wide and 20ins deep. The material was also laced with artist's graphite to give it an other-worldly sheen. Not only this, but an obnoxious smelling, jelly-like goo made from boiled bread dough was injected into each unit before sealing, so if anybody tried drilling into the inside they would be in for a nasty surprise. Finally a small electronic loudspeaker, programmed to emit a wailing sound if the UFO was disturbed was mounted on the inside. The total unit weighed about a hundredweight (112 lbs) so did not resemble a flimsy toy. It was agreed that each of the 6 constructions would be placed at equidistant points along the 51.5 degree parallel running from Kent to Somerset to add 'intelligence' to the situation.

Locations were the Isle of Sheppey and Bromley, Kent, Welford and Winkfield, Berkshire, Chippenham, Wilts and Clevedon, Somerset. Nothing special about the actual placements which were fields, back gardens or golf courses. The first object was found at 8.00 am; the last not until mid-day. By 9.00 am the MOD had details on their desks and a senior unnamed flight lieutenant was placed in charge of the investigation. All concerned took this most seriously with the over-riding fear that the Soviets had planted a surprise attack on the UK. Utmost secrecy was imposed, but already the press had got wind of the situation, and a mass of reporters thronged around Bromley police station at the same time as one of the saucers was being off loaded there.

Radiation checks were made at Bromley, but these proved negative. Drilling was carried out which exposed the rotten smelling brew inside. Apparently the Winkfield plant remained silent with the beeper proving faulty, and was placed in the lost property office at the local police station. At Chippenham the object was blown up in a controlled explosion - fatal should the inside have been laced with anthrax spores for instance.

Eventually the students' cover was blown by a local reporter at Farnborough, who was aware the same group had built a realistic robot for Rag week the year before and put two and two together. A press conference was convened late on where the students confessed all, much to the acute embarrassment of the authorities. As a result of the publicity, £2,000 was raised for charity and offers were received from all over the world for the surviving saucers. One was put on display in a West End restaurant and the Isle of Sheppey example taken by the helicopter crew that picked it up in the first place.

ALIEN LIFE FOUND IN METEORITE? A NASA scientist, Dr Richard Hoover, claims to have discovered the remains of a form of alien life. These 'aliens' are microscopic fossils found in a sample of 9 rare meteorites found in Antarctica, Alaska and Siberia known as carbonaceous chondrites. By splitting open the rocks and using high powered scanning electron microscopes, Hoover claims to have viewed fossils of 'cyanobacteria', which are related but not the same as microscopic forms on Earth.

Dr Hoover suggest meteors spread organisms around the universe which remain dormant until certain atmospheric conditions allow growth and evolvement. This supports the original 'panspermia' theory of Dr Fred Hoyle - that life is everywhere and that life on Earth may have come from other planets.

Hoover has made claims of this nature before, but other scientists disagree that he has viewed life-forms.

In terms of development, most of these claimed discoveries only represent life as it would have existed on Earth 3 billion years ago. The leap forward to 'intelligence' only appears to exist with ourselves although anecdotal evidence suggests otherwise.

CROP CIRCLES APPEAR IN INDONESIA: Already crop circles are listed for 2011, with 3 quite sophisticated designs appearing in paddy fields of Java, Indonesia on January 23rd, 25th and 29th. This has the triple impact of being an unusual time, unusual place and unusual crop (rice). The largest formation at Krasahanhmlet, Sleman, Yogyakrta has a diameter of 25-30 metres and resembles typical wheat pictograms found in England. NEW ZEALAND RELEASES UFO FILES: New Zealand's confidential UFO reports were released under freedom of information laws in December 2010 after members of the New Zealand Defence Force deleted names and other identifying information. There are stated to be 2,000 pages of documents dated from 1954 to 2009, and includes reports from citizens, military personnel and commercial pilots. Most UFOs are reported as mysterious lights in the sky, but there are also drawings of flying saucers, descriptions of aliens wearing pharoah-like masks and alleged samples of extraterrestrial writing. The Defence Force spokesman said they do not have the resources to investigate UFO reports.

RAF RUDLOE MANOR REVEALED: As part of the release of another batch of MOD files to the National Archive, readers may be interested in obtaining information on this base which was believed to be involved with covert research into UFOs as far back as the 1980s. A well known ufologist was arrested there and passed on the name of the establishment to Contact. Later a group of 'truthseekers' invaded some of the underground facilities at Rudloe Manor, but did not appear to find anything of mindblowing significance. The material is background to a parliamentary question by Liberal Democrat M.P, Matthew Taylor. The accompanying background note is possibly more revealing.

ANSWER

RAF Rudloe Manor is an administrative unit providing support for a number of independent organisations. The following units are located there:

Unit

Function

RAF Provost and Security Services

Security support, criminal investigations and provost operations assistance to the RAF.

Provost and Security Services (Western Region)

Specialist police and security support to all RAF establishments within the West Midlands, the West Country and Mid Wales.

Defence Vetting Agency (RAF)

Security clearances for RAF's military and civilian personnel, and defence industry employees.

Defence Communication Services Agency

The Services Management Centre of the Agency, including the Primary Network Control Centre of the Defence Fixed Telecommunications Service.

Detachment of 1001 Signals Unit, RAF

Participation in the operation of the UK military communications satellite system.



PO 3104i: BACKGROUND NOTE

- 1. The only difficulty with questions of this nature about RAF Rudloe Manor is that we do not refer to the existence of an underground facility. This is a defence installation for use in peace and war, and includes both civil and military communications facilities and stores depots. We seek to preserve the details of the facility under the security provision of the Open Government Code. In not referring to it, the answer is arguably incomplete; nonetheless reference to it is not recommended. Should the Minister want further information, Sec(MSF)1 can brief separately. A number of correspondents have over time indicated broad knowledge of the facility, and its role, but we have declined to confirm any of their suppositions.
- 2. This apart, it is not obvious why Mr Taylor has asked this question, although the Minister will be aware that Mr Taylor is a well known and persistent questioner on nuclear matters. In this connection, it should be noted that, although the Corsham Computer Centre (CCC) is close to RAF Rudloe Manor, it is not connected with it physically or functionally. It occupies a chamber of an old quarry working and is the responsibility of the MOD Procurement Executive (PE), whose role is to obtain the equipment required by the Armed Forces. The facility houses a suite of PE computers which are sited underground so that (like those of London Transport) they are insulated from environmental effects.
- 3. RAF Rudloe Manor attracts much interest and speculation from the UFO fraternity, and it may be that a constituent of Mr Taylor has prompted his question.
- 4. RAF Rudloe Manor is situated in Wiltshire between Bath and Corsham and is spread over 4 separate sites. Some 607 Service and 233 civilian personnel are currently employed there. Minister will recall that No 1 Site of RAF Rudloe Manor is to close by 31 March 1999, with the exception of an element of the Defence Vetting Agency, which will be enclaved on site for a further period. The announcement was made on 20 April following a period of consultation. The closure involves the relocation of the P&SS units, which will be followed by a similar, as yet undetermined, move for DVA(RAF). There will be some 70 civilian job losses, including some redundancies.

DOWNGRADED TO UNCLASSIFIED 23/3/10 by Criginates CONFIDENTIAL DEPSIES

The ever increasing numbers of wind turbines across the British landscape and off shore is a result of a government pledge to produce around a third of our electrical energy from renewable sources within ten years - a target agreed with the EU. Noble 'green' ambitions are to be admired, but turbines are so ridiculously inefficient that conventional power station back-up must be on hand virtually all the time. In the extreme cold spell of December, 2010, UK temperatures dropped to near -20°C at times, following heavy snowfalls, but at the same time the wind dropped away to almost zero, so turbines produced no electricity and the high loading requirement had to be met by importing power from France. Ironically this source was probably derived from nuclear power stations - the sworn enemy of the 'Green' movement.

Each unit of modern design is about 350ft tall - as high as Nelson's column - and rotates with a regular 'clunk' rather than a continuous whirring sound, probably a gearing arrangement to prevent the blades shearing off. This continuous thudding sound and the sheer presence of the turbines has known to give great distress to residents living within a mile of the construction. Recently we have received reports of a supposed collision with a UFO in Lincolnshire where one blade fell off and another was severely buckled, and a crop circle that was placed at the exact centre of an array of 5 turbines near Shrivenham, Oxon, with a design that may have been offering advice!

The government is involved with huge projects to build farms off shore and on windswept moorlands, but smaller groups or individuals can place one or two turbines on their land which offer vast subsidies far and above the value of any electricity generated. Where planning permission is sought fierce opposition from local residents can be guaranteed as things stand at the present. A usually absent owner can collar 100 or even up to 200% of the value of the electricity the turbine produces, but leaving the locals with many sleepless nights! One example quoted is a single placement close to the M4 motorway outside Reading, where the turbine generated just 15% of its annual capacity and received a £130,000 subsidy for producing just £100,000 of electricity. Another giant enterprise built by a Swedish firm off the coast of Kent at a cost of £800 million was rated to produce 300 megawatts of power, enough to provide green power for tens of thousands of homes, but is only generating 80 megawatts in practice - a tenth that supplied by a gas powered station. This will result in taxpayers paying a subsidy of £60 million a year or £1.5 billion over the 25 year lifespan of the turbines.

The government is seeking to spend £100 billion in building 10,000 more turbines plus £40 billion in connecting them to the national grid and a further £100 billion in building back-up conventional power stations, all by 2020. The one time industrial revolution scenery of tall factory chimneys - now almost defunct - will be placed by even taller monstrosities and these will be placed in some of the most beautiful countryside of Britain.

On the continent, Denmark, a key builder of turbines has the highest electricity prices in Europe and needs to import from abroad. Germany has built more turbines than any country in the world, but is now building new coal-fired stations, and Holland is removing subsidies against EU regulations.

Wind turbines produce no electricity below a wind speed of c10 mph. Above a speed of c55 mph units are closed down for safety reasons. Over Britain on 110 days a year there is no wind strong enough. Is this the way forward?

"ALIEN LIFE"

The headline in an article by Robin Lloyd,the *LiveScience* Senior Editor posted on 14th February 2009 stated that a strange new genetic code was sitting in a laboratory in Florida showing it to be the first example of an artificial chemical system that is capable of Darwinian evolution.

Apparently the system is made up of four molecules that are the basic building blocks of our DNA mixed with eight synthetic modifications. The difference between the synthetic molecules and those that make up conventional DNA is that these cannot make copies of themselves as yet but this could all change in the future with further research.

Steven A Benner of the Foundation for Applied Molecular Evolution in Gainesville USA stated that "One of the ways scientists try to understand life as a universal concept is to try and create it in your own laboratory putting together chemicals that could possibly work to form new types of life". He and his colleagues have focused in part on expanding the DNA alphabet to develop and "Artificially Expanded Genetic Information System" which now has its own supporting molecular biology.

American Association for the Advancement of Science offers ideas about new types of life for scientists to look for beyond our planet as Benner explained "The life that is encountered off Earth will not necessarily have the same biochemistry as ours" therefore a study of unusual building blocks of life rather than just our own could be the way forward for alien life.

The research has also in turn resulted from a NASA funded project to try and understand what life might look like beyond the Earth. Such life might live in water, but it could also live in liquid nitrogen or methane (Saturn's moon Titan possibly) or in environments with extremely high or low acidity.

NASA has been involved in searching for extra-terrestrial life along numerous avenues for decades, including the Viking mission to Mars in the 1970's and in its recent missions. NASA is also involved with funding many researchers around the world studying the origins, evolution, distribution and future of life in the universe.

We know that NASA has found life (not ET unfortunately) in toxic, arsenic riddled Mono Lake in California USA which is a type of bacteria with a DNA makeup that they never thought was possible. The building blocks of life –carbon, hydrogen, nitrogen, oxygen phosphorus and sulphur are not all present. As opposed to phosphorus, this bacteria's DNA uses arsenic,

Now we can begin to look outside our planet for extra-terrestrial life forms without preconceived ideas that it has to be made up of our building blocks – it could take any forms both ours and unknown quantities which will help it to survive in alien environments.

There has been past encounters with aliens that could, with the help of DNA checks, have answered a lot of questions regarding abduction cases. Especially as some of those encounters resulted in subjects being returned with wrong clothing, sexual assaults etc., all could have been DNA tested with what might make some very interesting results. It also of course might have proven the case for the unfortunate witness who was trying to convince others that their experience was real.

There was a case of Russian geneticists in 2007 who were trying to unravel a mystery surrounding a strange creature entitled the "Uralien alien". This was a tiny creature found near the town of Kyshtym in the Urals. After carrying out tests, they discovered in the DNA samples a gene which did not correspond with any genes pertaining to humans or anthropoid apes. The experts in DNA research have not come across any creatures with such an elongated DNA molecule. This has been an ongoing investigation for many years.

The story is that in the summer of 1996 a miniature creature was found in the Chelyabinsk region. The find was soon dubbed the "Kyshtym Alien" and after an autopsy report was carried out, the conclusion was that the dead body was neither human nor animal in nature.

Ufologists regarded the small creature as a clear cut case of an extraterrestrial. The religious orders dubbed it a demon. The creature was still alive when it was found by an old and "barely literate" woman. She was the only one who gave the tiny creature a name Alioshenka.

The dwarfed being did not do any harm to anybody whilst living and whilst in the care of the old lady but after the "alien" died the old lady was killed in a hit and run accident, strangely just before a team of researchers arrived in the town of Kyshtym to question her about Alioshenka.

It also came to light that the actual body of the being disappeared without trace. Someone assigned to the case is reported to have handed the body over to perpetrators who just walked off with it.

Mr Mark Milkhiker looked into the Kystyn phenomenon on location. He carefully examined the area in which the dwarf/alien was found and fell seriously ill shortly after he returned to Moscow. He died of a sudden heart attack whilst in hospital. Another mysterious disease paralysed Vadim Chernobrove who was also taken ill four years after the discovery of the dwarf whilst he worked on a piece of fabric used by the old lady to wrap the dwarf on the day she found him, co-incidence perhaps, but death certainly shrouds the alien mystery.

Out of the numerous witnesses that had dealings with the body, a former investigator with the Police Department Major (Ret) Vladimir Bendlin who had confiscated a bundle being carried by a detained suspected robber and saw what was a small mummified body of a strange creature. The police placed the corpse on the cloth and videotaped it. Bendlin noticed immediately that it looked like an alien as portrayed in Sci Fi movies. An investigation is usually carried out on all dead bodies in normal circumstances - and in line with regulations the police had to determine the cause of death of the strange being.

The doctor's verdict was not as Bendlin suspected that of an unborn malformed child having been covered up, but of a creature that was neither human nor animal, according to the official report it was some new life form. The doctor stated the creature was not by any means a human being as the human skull consists of six bones the skull of the creature was made up of 4 bones. There were differences in the skeleton structure as well. The doctor was quite clear this was no earthly being and the DNA results were very startling.

Perhaps we should look to Zecharia Sitchin's "There Were Giants Upon the Earth" book when he suggests Adam was made in the image of the gods of Sumer and Babylon – the Anunnaki who came to Earth from their planet Bibiru. Adam was genetically engineered with the genes of the Anunnaki and the existing hominids some 300,000 years ago. Perhaps we are after all descendants of demi-gods. Sitchin reveals a DNA source in ancient writings and artefacts that

could prove the biblical and Sumerian tales are true. Providing conclusive physical evidence for past alien presence on Earth and which could be an unprecedented scientific opportunity to track down the "missing link" in humankinds evolution.

There is also a petition on http://www.ipetitions.com/petition/aliendna to demand the evidence of Alien DNA appealing to the Natural History Museum in London to allow an internationally coordinated DNA extraction from the skeletal remains of the goddess Nin.Puabi (discovered at the Royal Tombs of Ur) in order to compare her genome to ours. Nin.Puabi is supposedly a direct descendant of extraterrestrial visitors to Earth. If tested, her bones could reveal the DNA differences that represent the "missing genetic link" that small but crucial group of "alien genes" that upgrade us from wild hominids to modern man.

The film Avatar is perhaps a good link in mixing alien and human DNA and could be prophetic for the future as we are exploring further and further into the unchartered universe and it is increasingly likely we are going to meet other species from new worlds maybe not that different from our own. Perhaps we are a result of some earlier source of specie who explored our world eons ago for minerals etc., just as we are going to be doing the same in the future in space.

We also should consider the Sydney Australia abduction experience from 1992 which incredibly had biological evidence and which became the subject of the worlds first DNA PCR(polymerase Chain Reaction) related investigation. This was extensively covered by Bill Chalker in the oz files and his paper "The Worlds first DNA PCR investigation of Biological Evidence from an Aljen Abduction".

Peter Khoury in July 1988 lay on his bed and suddenly became paralysed. He could see a number of beings around him, one being was a tall, thin, golden yellow colour with large black eyes who inserted a long needle like object in the side of his head. Khoury blacked out. He regained consciousness with a start and rushed into adjoining rooms where he found his family members all asleep. Khoury then found it was 1-2 hours later rather than the initial 10 minutes which he thought had passed. Khoury had had unusual experiences before this date.

In 1992 Khoury felt unwell and came home at 7.00am he lay down on the bed and went to sleep he awoke with a start becoming aware of something alighting on the bed, he was shocked to see two strange women at the end of the bed.

Both were unclad, one looked Nordic and the other of Asian appearance. The Nordic female had a very elongated face and sharply pointed chin. Her eyes looked blue and 3 times larger than normal. She had fine wispy blonde hair that seemed to stand out from her head. The darker skinned Asian looking woman had completely black eyes and her hair was jet black and set in a page boy style.

The Nordic woman seemed to be conversing with the Asian female and then the Nordic woman attempted to pull Khoury to her as in a sexual advance and Koury terrified fought to resist her this tussle went on for a few times until Khoury bit the breast of the woman and bit through the nipple. She did not seemed in pain or the marked area did not bleed but she looking puzzled, seemed as though she was saying to the other woman that this should not normally happen. Khoury then had a violent coughing fit and when he looked up both women had disappeared.

Khoury then went to the bathroom for a drink of water after coughing so much and when he went to urinate he found some very fine blonde hair around his penis area. It was not until 1996 that

the hair sample was mentioned to Bill Chalker and from what he understood to be an alien abduction sexual assault case. In 1998 Chalker then began an investigation into the hair sample.

Bill Chalker then put into motion the first PCR DNA profiling of biological material implicated in an alien abduction experience. The analysis confirmed the hair came from someone who was biologically close to normal human genetics but of an unusual racial type – a rare Chinese Mongoloid type- one of the rarest human lineages known, that lies further from the human mainstream than any other except for African pygmies and aboriginals.

The study concluded it was of a person who had skin and hair of very little colour, as a form of protection against the sun or perhaps because she does not require it. SIGHTING REPORTS By Data Research

Place: Wantage Oxon UK Source: www.uk-ufo.co.uk Time 22.25

Date: 9th January 2011

Witness Statement: At approximately 22.25 my partner and I were having a smoke break on the balcony of our 2nd floor flat. The balcony faces due East. The sky was clear with stars visible and light westerly winds. We noticed a bright white light through the trees in a NE direction and I assumed it was an aircraft or helicopter coming towards us, although most commercial aircraft are usually travelling at high altitude.

A few minutes later the light cleared the trees and was heading in a SE direction crossing from left to right. It was impossible to gauge any distance or height but the light initially appeared as landing lights on a plane. The speed I can equate to at least twice the speed of the usual air traffic travelling overhead, which I assume to be between 20,000 and 30,000 feet, and slightly slower than police helicopters which I assume usually travel at roughly the same speed. The light maintained a straight path and did not accelerate or change speed although I did notice a red light flashing which appeared to be just behind the main light, my partner did not observe this.

I would consider it to be closest at an elevation of approximately 45 degrees when it passed over the flats. It caught my attention as at no stage were any port or starboard lights visible, apart from the single small flashing red light. No strobe navigations lights were visible. \sim The light did not dim in any way . It was exceptionally brighter than any plane light and there was no sound at all

Witness 2 Statement: I live in Witney, Oxfordshire UK and on the 9th January 2011 I looked up to check the bright southern star and noticed there were two. I scanned the rest of the sky and by the time I'd turned around, the star had moved. It was heading towards South Oxford which is East south East of Witney.

It was certainly travelling a lot faster than an aeroplane. I could gauge this from the plane that was coming in from the west. The plane seemed to be at a fairly high altitude, I could pick out the flashing and coloured lights still and living near Brize Norton I am familiar with planes at night.

I thought the light must have been Venus or some planet but the problem with that was it was going in the opposite direction.

Place: Tooting, London UK Source: Original Time 15.00approx
Date: 12th February 2010

Witness Statement: At the time of the sighting I was staying at a Hospital. I saw a balloon like object that had a light underneath it. I thought at first it must be a balloon of some sort then I spotted another similar one dark with a light underneath it.

The objects bobbed about for a while and then rose up into the clouds and disappeared. Then I saw through the clouds another one appeared. They were all equally spaced out and all moved in the same direction. It was the fact that they were very black in appearance and with a single bright light underneath which made me sure they were not balloons at all.

They went behind a building and I lost sight of them and then I saw from behind the building they all rose up into the clouds and disappeared.

Time 6.30am onwards
Date: 11th September 2004

Witness Statement: My wife and I left our daughters house in Burghfield, Reading heading for Tilehurst early in the morning between 6.30am and 8.30am. I glanced out at the trees on my side of the vehicle we were in and my wife screamed "WATCH OUT" I hit the brakes and managed to stop "What's is wrong with you" my wife said, by this time I was looking straight ahead afraid

to look again without her confirmation. "Take a look out of my window and what can you see" "A Spaceship" she replied and I then drove on up the road to get a better view.

My emotions went from being scared to death one minute to amazement in the next, almost a feeling of privilege, this craft was hovering over a filed no more than 50 yards away about 200 feet in the air, it was 100-200 yards across, 30 yards deep. It was Saturn like in shape and had a set of windows running through the middle all different colours. They looked as though they could be flashing but maybe it was the rushing clouds inside the craft that gave this impression. The clouds were all small but were different shades and they looked as if they were thundery rushing through the ship.

It was at this point I told myself to remember every detail as I was seeing something that will get investigated and would need to recall all the details at some point. We watched it for about five minutes, no more than that, then the ship moved off in an arc shape to our right going up as it moved. Its path took it straight over the atomic research base 500 yards away, then it went parallel to the M4 Motorway towards London and this was where we lost sight of it.. I drove on up the road to see if there was any further sighting of the object.

The weather was fine and dry - the sky was blue but no sunshine and not a cloud in the sky.

We went home and told our family about it, some laughed and others were skeptic. There was a newspaper article some 3 days later asking if anyone had seen a UFO - I was expecting the press to be full of the sighting with many people seeing it but there was nothing at all mentioned and it got me thinking "I wonder Why"?

Place: Tasmania, Australia Source: Original Time 01.00: approx Date: Summer 1966-67

Witness Statement: During the summer of 1966/7 in Hobart, Tasmania, Australia a group of my school frields and I were camping on Seven Mile Beach., It was a "tradition" to wander this beach at night – it was a wonderful time of freedom – none of us used drugs or alcohol.

I was sitting in the hollow of a sand dune with a friend when another of our friends who was standing on the top of the dune yelled to me to come quickly because there was a UFO.

Thinking she was having a joke I ran up the dune (10 feet) to see a row of very distinct bright white lights just hovering – it must have been 2-3 miles away. The lights were so bright and pulsating that it was not possible to see the actual body of the craft. There was not any sound-that was what surprised my friend - as the surrounding bushland and sea did not reflect any noise which you would have thought it would have done especially at that time of night. The lights continued to hover in one place for what seemed a couple of minutes in what seemed to be one place, then within seconds it then changed to a pulsating red and slowly moved off to the right and diappeared over the horizon of low hills.

We went to notify the newspaper Hobart Mercury, they wrote to say it was a cargo plane and as no one else believed us the matter was forgotten.

Place: North Moreton, Oxon UK Source: www.uk-ufo.co.uk Time: 19.00 Date: August 1965 Witness Statement: This extraordinary event happened to my sister and I on a warm August evening in 1965. It was reported in the local press and investigated by the local police and air force officials from RAF Benson but the sighting was never officially listed.

We lived in the village of North Moreton which at the time was quite remote, our house bordered onto fields which if followed for about 4 miles would lead to Didcot, Oxon. I was just eight years old and my sister was six.

It was a warm evening and my sister and I decided to give the dog a walk. He was a very protective dog so our parents never feared for our safety and we were always told to keep him on a rope, which we duly did. We were making our way back through open fields keeping to the tractor ways and with the house in sight "Buster" the dog suddenly began yelping and leaping in the air dragging me forward so hard that I let him go. He raced towards the house and I turned to my sister whose hand I was holding and said "What's up with Buster" at that instant we were both immersed in light and sound.

An object the size of a small car quickly descended over us with a light so bright that one of my clearest memories is looking at the grass at my feet and being unable to lift my head. The sound was a constant hum/purr and there was a strange feeling in our hair and on our skin. I panicked and ran a few paces and left my sister who then screamed and screamed. As I turned to her and shouted "run" I could see the object through the light...it was no more than a few feet above her head, as she ran towards me it followed her for a few yards. Then, in a blink of an eye it shot straight up into the clear sky with incredible speed.

I recall seeing it as a tiny round speck, the ascent being followed by what I described at the time as "thunder in sky". Almost petrified with fear I ran to the house screaming for my parents leaving my sister to make her own way back. My mother ran back up the fields and scooped her up.

Even though we had no knowledge of UFO's or any idea of what we had seen the incident had a profound effect on us. In fact a farmer had a similar encounter with an identical objects some weeks later that it was then my parents phoned the police who in turn contacted the RAF.

To this day my memory of the event is vivid and my mind can picture the object ascending that it will stay with me forever.

Witness Statement: I was in my back garden going towards my car on my out for the evening. The sky was perfectly clear as it looked as though it was going to be frosty and I could see all the stars clearly. Suddenly I saw a round orange pulsating light approaching fast from the SSE. It was probably about 1000 feet and moving rapidly but not so fast that it could be tracked easily.

There was no sound whatsoever and I tracked it until it went out of sight. It was not a helicopter or a plane as far as I could see and having experience in aviation I know what a plane and helicopter look and sound like having flown paragliders/paramotors for 10 years.

It was definitely not a balloon or lantern as this thing was propelled.

Place: Horton cum Studley, Oxfordshire and Lower Heyford, Oxford. UK

Witness Statement 1. Driving along the road between Horton Cum Studley and Boarstall I saw what appeared to be three very bright lights omitting sparkler like debris flying through the sky. I stopped the car and watched this and a car 300 yards in front of me also stopped to watch it. My only explanation would have been an aerobatic display team practising some manoeuvres But this is unlikely as it appeared to be on too big a scale and looked dangerous due to the huge amount of sparkler like debris trailing behind.

Witness Statement 2. Two of us were travelling in the car and as we drove away from Lower Heyford towards the M40 We could see what looked like a firework sparkler but on a much larger scale. There appeared to be 2 objects together each with a long wavering tail and tracing an undulating path. Definitely not a firework and not an aircraft – but very pretty.

MISSING OR ABDUCTED?

In the realms of ufology 'ABDUCTION' is a familiar concept wherein a witness or abductee is removed by alien forces or beings and taken on board a spacecraft with possible removal to other planets or at least outside the Earth's atmosphere. 'Missing time' is often reported in such circumstances. Recollections of events are often enhanced by hypnotic regression, but this procedure may not be fully objective. Physical experiments carried out on abductees may result in skin reddening or minor lacerations, but these are the only definite physical proof that something unusual occurred during the claimed period of absence. The rest of the evidence is strictly anecdotal, and in no known cases has an abductee been placed on a missing persons list by their friends or relatives.

What we might term as a true abduction - where the person disappears entirely without trace - is another matter. Is there any evidence that people are being carried off in alien craft never to return? I was recently drawn to a Sunday newspaper headline that 300,000 people a year disappear in Britain. On checking websites on this subject, the figure is reduced to 250,000 - but still substantial. Most organisations agree that 99% of the missing turn up again within a year, but this still leaves a long term residue of 1% amounting to 2,500 in Britain which of course accumulates over long periods. Comparative figures for the USA are 900,000 missing a year or around 2,300 every day. For Australia the claim is 35,000 a year. Other possibly related figures indicate around 1,000 people are murdered annually in England, Wales and Scotland, and 80,000 are currently in prison - a number which seems to have increased considerably over the last 5 years.

Readers may recall in the wonderful UFO film Close Encounters of the Third Kind (1977) that in the final great climatic scene a large number of supposed human abductees emerge from the Mother Ship to be exchanged for a new quota of volunteers as far as we are able to ascertain. Amongst the released personnel are the crew of Flight 19, that went missing in the 'Bermuda Triangle' on December 5th, 1945, on a routine training exercise. The flight of 5 TBM Avenger torpedo bombers took off from Fort Lauderdale, Florida, heading out over the Caribbean Sea. Neither the aircraft nor the 14 crew members were ever seen again after radio contact was lost, a few hours into the mission. Director Spielberg and his writers developed the mischievous notion that a whole squadron of aircraft and their occupants

could be spirited away in an alien spaceship and returned to Earth several years into the future. Total nonsense you might think, but I was informed at the time that the film was based on true facts and used the famous ufologist, Dr J. Allen Hynek, as consultant, and he actually played a cameo part in the final landing sequences.

Back to reality - is there any proof that missing persons could be disappearing into thin air in a literal alien abduction scenario? From the files of www.missingpeople.org.uk a sample of 100 cases has been selected from about 500 currently being publicised. These are not selected entirely at random, but from more rural areas avoiding large conurbations such as London and the West Midlands where people can easily vanish without being missed. A large number of non-British immigrants/students with foreign sounding names are also omitted as many of these may be seeking to stay in the country when their visas run out and conveniently disappear as a result.

Of those remaining the sample of 100 points to a large male majority 80/20, male/female, which may not be entirely surprising, as males are more likely to be wandering about particularly at night with a higher tendency to get involved with confrontational situations. In terms of age, the majority missing are between 21 and 40 years - the prime of life - so will be of more concern to relatives, but there are several from most age ranges as seen in the table below. A further analysis of those missing shows that a period of 1 to 5 years is the most common, but a few go beyond 15 years - even up to 30 years.

It is unlikely that any significant facts can be assumed from the above tables, but I have noted where the disappeared are described as behaving 'entirely out of character'. This amounts to 24 out of the 100 sampled - certainly a significant percentage. It is assumed these persons have no mental illness and are not involved in covert relationships or have

money troubles, although a full profile of such individuals can never be known for certain even to close relatives.

Individually, certain cases point to a possibility of abduction - a male aged 28 from Bromley. Kent, missing for 10 years, was last seen going for a walk on the downs; a female from Redruth, Cornwall, missing for 4 years, drove off in her car which is also unaccounted for; and a woman, aged 34, from Gloucester, missing for 16 years left her car with the keys still in the ignition and her glasses on the dashboard.

Unfortunately 'dark forces' of the human kind are at work everywhere. Mass murderers who have killed mainly female victims at random while driving around the country usually as part of their job, are almost certain to have concealed other serious crimes apart from the ones they have been convicted of and sentenced to long terms in prison. Cases involving children under ten can usually be ascribed to paedophiles or abductors particularly in foreign countries. (The case of doctors' daughter, Madeleine McCann, which completely overwhelmed the newspapers in 2007 has still not been solved inspite of locals in the Portuguese holiday town of Praia da Luz being accused of kidnapping and even the parents themselves somehow responsible. Dozens of psychics were supposedly sorting out the mystery - but their deliberations came to nothing.) Recently a 35 year old female chef, Claudia Lawrence, from York vanished without trace when supposedly going to work in the early morning of March 18th, 2009. A massive police investigation since then has failed to make a single arrest or recover a body. The only known facts are that Claudia led a very secretive and complicated love life which may eventually expose her abductor and/or murderer.

Fully mature males are of course less likely to have been sexually attacked or murdered, except possibly those that have gone missing after attending night clubs or late night parties and these make up the greater part of our 'missing' sample. The modern concepts of on-line dating and chat room affiliations can only increase the numbers of abductions or disappearances, wherein those of evil intent can use all manner of means to conceal their identities.

As previously mentioned one cannot draw any definite conclusions from the data and this is mainly an exercise in providing facts which we may not be aware of. There is some indication that people just 'disappear off the face of the Earth' - to where who knows!

FOOTNOTE: A typical case of abduction and murder of an attractive young woman has just occurred. Unfortunately the victim, Sian O'Callaghan, elected to leave a Swindon night club unescorted around 3 am and was believed to have made a text message from Savernake forest near Marlborough. The forest was then searched by thousands of volunteers, but smart detective work identified a local cab driver as the likely abductor, and he immediately confessed and lead the police to a body near White Horse Hill, Uffington, Oxon. Further he unexpectedly revealed to have murdered another woman from Swindon around 2003 and disposed of the body near Northleach, Glos. After digging up the edge of a field, human remains were found. The related point to the above study is that, up to the present time, nobody knows who this person is as it does not tally with any missing person from the Swindon area. With the huge advances in DNA techniques, we will no doubt eventually establish the identity and from what part of the country she came.

Here is some text written on the base of the coffins in the Great Pyramid:

EVERY SHINING OTHERWORLD FORM SHALL APPEAR IN ANY FORM CHOSEN DURING DAY AND SHALL ENTER THE HIDDEN GATE IN POWER.

(Concerning Horus) --

THE GREAT GOD OF THE DISC COMES FORTH IN THE SUN AND MOON. ALL THE SHINING FORMS OF THE UNDERWORLD RECEIVE HIM AT HIS HORIZON OF AMENTET.

(From the ancient book of the two paths) --THESE ARE THE METHODS OF OSIRIS THEY ARE ON THE EDGE OF THE SKY AS FOR ANY PERSON WHO KNOWS THIS PROCEDURE FOR GOING DOWN BY THEM --IS A HOLY GOD IN THE SUITE OF THOTH, MOREOVER HE CAN GO DOWN INTO ANY SKY HE CHOOSES.

Some might say this merely concerns the Sun, however note that Horus (Heru) is the same as Helu, related to the Greek, Hellos, though Heru refers to any shining thing in the sky including the fiery ring seen by the adviser to Thutmose III (nineteenth dynasty), thus HeruSept means Horus the dogstar, HeruSpares means Horus, star of the south, and so forth; the Sun and the Moon being the eyes of Horus.

Now perhaps just as for the case of Ea, the star of the sea, a supernova seen in ancient times, the Babylonian people seemed to benefit much from seeing this apparition, so also the Egyptians benefitted from their interest in Sirius and the stars in the belt of the constellation of Orion. They may actually have had psychic if not actual meetings with forces from beyond our sphere, possibly then and conceivably possible now - the difficulty in ancient times was physical, the difficulty now is mental, belonging to a civilisation that has made escaping from external influences into a fine art.

A DISC SETS IN AMENTET. EVERY SHINING OTHERWORLD FORM SHALL APPEAR IN ANY OTHER FORM DURING DAY, IN ANY FORM CHOSEN, AND SHALL ENTER THE HIDDEN GATE IN POWER.

Now consider some of Captain Jim Howard's account of the event witnessed from the Sratocruiser GALSC, (BOAC Flight 510 from New York, Idlewild on 29/6/54 departing at 21.03 GMT for London). Crossing the estuary of the St Lawrence River near Seven Islands, Quebec, Canada, pilot and co-pilot some objects off the port side paralleling them: "the Sun is low in the north west--- still about half an hour before sunset, visibility excellent--- all observed (the rest of the flight deck crew had by now spotted them too) they climbed steadily up until they appeared at the same altitude as our selves, maintaining station off our port, distance unknown-- possibly a mile or two from us-- seven objects in all, one large, six small, strung out in a horizontal line, here the small ones moved steadily in relation to the larger, so that sometimes there are two ahead, four behind, sometimes three ahead, three behind-- the large object changed shape several time, gradually assuming different

silhouettes, but the small ones always appeared globular. The colour appeared dark grey, and silhouetted as they were against a dark sky, sharp edged and opaque. I sketched the appearance of them several times during the twenty minutes that they flew alongside, covering some 80 miles in this time -- I did not alter course, the aircraft is autopilot throughout, heading for Goose Bay. After a moment the stewardess came to the flight deck and told me that the passengers are all seeing the things and could I tell them about the objects - I couldn't".

They contacted Goose bay and a radioequipped nightfighter came to investigate, having a radar contact 20 miles ahead and closing fast. All small objects disappeared into the large object and vanished. The fighter pilot asked for advice -- "I told him there is only one left and gave him the bearing to steer-- as I did this the object seemed to shrink quite rapidly until completely gone".

ALL OBJECTS ENTERED THE HIDDEN GATE IN POWER.

Landing at 01.51 GMT just after sunset, they are questioned by a USAF officer, who did not seem at all surprised implying that such sightings are common in that area.

Here is another quote from the Ancient Book of the Two Paths:

I AM THE ONE THAT REPELS THE OPPOSITION OF THE AGGRESSOR THAT TRAVELS AND FLIES UP

I AM THE ONE THAT IS BENEATH THE EGG

MY DIGNITY IS HERE BY HIS APPEARANCE

ON APPEARING IN THE EARLY MORNING

HIS DIGNITY IS GUARDED BECAUSE I HAVE ATTAINED THIS

On 18th September 1976 at around 10.30pm the inhabitants of the Iranian capital Tehran informed the authorities of things in the sky. The airbase at Shahrokhi became informed and they had the object on radar 80 miles away, and could see the object visually. Two F4 fighters were scrambled, though found on approach that their fire control systems and electronics were out of action, though the function returned with increasing distance. A smaller object attached itself from the larger object and darted towards one of the F4, Phantoms, that fired an Aims rocket and again all electronics failed, and the pilot steered out towards the desert. The small object returned to the large object that had red green and blue lights and was the size of a Boeing 707. Eventually the planes ran low on fuel and returned to base.

Note this case came to light not only through declassified CIA documents referring to it, but the Iranian authorities took the unusual step of making a film about the event and similar encounters near the time, and again in September 1976 a large multicoloured object flew the length of the runway at Tehran Airport, failing the electronics, lights and power supplies rather dramatically. This case was used as the first part of the end sequence in the film 'Close Encounters of the Third Kind'. Not many patrons realised that the film is mainly a composition of dramatic true UFO cases. For example a vibrating sign sequence reflects a true event at a French location, Vins Sur Caraney, on 14/4/57, where a sign was seen to vibrate as an object passed overhead and was later shown to have become magnetised.

At Portage County, Ohio, USA, on the night of 16/4/66, Deputy Sheriff Neff and Deputy Sheriff Dale F Spaur were at the Atwater center when they heard of a sighting on the police radio. They lightheartedly turned onto route 224 and started to check an abandoned car

when a very bright humming object hovered above them. They jumped back into the patrol car and reported this to base; the object moved east and the suggestion came that they shoot. On pointing out that the object was the size of a house, they were told to follow. This they did for 70 miles at speeds up to to 105 mph. The object looked like an icecream cone with a flattened top and was seen by many witnesses fly past at 1,000 ft, suddenly stop, climb to 3,500 ft vertically, and then zoom on upwards until out of sight. As a result both sheriffs were treated mercilessly and lost their jobs to be followed by poor health and divorce.

Note this is the basis of the chase sequence in the CEIII film by Avenger aircraft which disappeared and were falsely claimed to have been found on the sea floor of the bay of Mexico, a fate that happened to an English Electric Lightning fighter interceptor over the North Sea - the plane being found intact at the bottom of the sea, canopy closed, but with no sign of the pilot.

Failing of power supplies is also common during overflights of UFOs which have been seen to be glowing brightly. For instance on 6/11/66 glowing UFOs are seen near power supplies at Niagara Falls and elsewhere just before the 'East Coast Blackout' of Canada and the USA.

Now consider that there are over 441 cases involving overflights of objects that affected vehicles, and the American Government body NICAP (National Investigations Committee on Aerial Phenomena) recognised this and produced over 104 cases in their official 1964 report. It is clear that there is incontrovertible technical proof that something exists that can cause these electrical failures. Now these objects may be highly active electrically charged bolides, or many other possibilities, and thus are definitely of interest to science. Science is interested in the former USSR and of events inside America, since the text of the Condon Report confirmed the UFO evidence, although the preface by Edward U condon did not. In fact 30 of 59 cases checked in detail by scientific means are in the affirmative that there is a mystery.

Hence official evidence (in Russia also) supports the UFO case in the sense of having come up holding inexplicable evidence about phenomena that are unknown meaning that the conclusion is not just 'insufficient evidence' or the data conflicts to any known phenomenon hypothesis. Consider that the technical data obtainable in theory even from the study of the flight behaviour of such objects is almost certainly valuable as data suggesting new avenues of thought - say backwards electromagnetism or perhaps a better theory of 'space'.

It is likely that the secure services undoubtedly do check such data for their own purposes and anything that is learned will be kept rather quiet, naturally.

Short term goals have overtaken long term goals, not only in this field, but in many other fields, and this is the trivial side of a more female cast of mind that is affecting our culture - as Aquarius matures from the developing stage into a more youthful middle life, the trends should become very beneficial.

It has been said: "Space travel is bilge" (Scottish Astronomer Royal 1956)

"In all probability there is not any other intelligent life in the Universe"

"Flying Saucers do not exist". Any of these statements can be proved wrong as the evidence stacks up over the years.

BOOK REVIEW: 'MIRAGE MEN' by Mark Pilkington

In this book Fortean writer, Mark Pilkington, goes deep into the inner secrets of the UFO world digging out the dirty truth what really happened in the USA post 1947. His implications are that CIA connected groups and the airforce special investigations unit, AFOSI, deliberately created situations and groomed certain scientists and investigators into promoting myths about UFOs and aliens. With a strong public belief that UFOs from outer space were buzzing the land, feeding the frenzy would distract attention away from secret weaponry being developed to combat the Soviet Union in the early years of the 'Cold War'.

Pilkington introduces himself as a former chairman of Norfolk UFO Society, NUFOS, in the volatile atmosphere of Norwich where ufology is particularly popular, but continually reinventing itself! It seems that Mark was considered too sceptical to chair the group and was replaced by a psychic who received alien messages through his television! We also learn that Pilkington is a member of 'Circlemakers' the notorious crop circle faking group and insists that all crop circles are man-made. For much of an extended fact finding mission to the States, the author is accompanied by John Lundberg, another member of the faking party. Somewhere deep into the book, Lundberg is revealed as the man who created the 1996 video of a crop circle forming near Devizes - probably one of half a dozen names suggested over the years!

The early chapters delve into some of the tangled history of UFO/USA. Particularly of interest is the concept of SERPO which is the name of the planet from where ETs or EBEns are alleged to have arrived in the Earth's atmosphere on 24th April 1964. An exchange between humans and visitors took place, and an 'Away Team' spent 13 years on Serpo, 38 light years away, not returning until 1978 minus 2 crew members who had died. Pilkington and Lundberg elect to attend the 2006, Laughlin conference in Nevada, where revelations about Serpo are expected. In fact half the book is based on interviews with contacts made at Laughlin.

From the experience of one CIUFOR observer who attended Laughlin in recent years, this is not the place to be with stifling atmosphere, tendencies to hallucinate and mini-earthquakes felt while in the lecture hall. Pilkington makes it clear that the audience may consist of government agents, disinformation specialists and just the occasional genuine UFO researcher. As the show goes on for several days fringe meetings abound where revelations and films of ETs are promised but never materialise as Pilkington and Lundberg are directed to empty side rooms. It would seem fairly natural therefore, that at the end of the conference proceedings our truthseekers are accused of being MI6 agents - which probably sums up the air of paranoia at Laughlin!

For much of the time spent in Nevada, the author is in the capable or devious hands of, Rick Doty, a former AFOSI officer. Pre-warned that Doty comes up with ever changing stories, Pilkington and Lundberg nevertheless form a good relationship with him during the proceedings. It is not intended to delve into all the names and places mentioned by Doty and others at Laughlin. After reading the first 200 pages the waters become somewhat muddied and confused!

What, if anything, substantial did Pilkington witness over in the States? Post conference Doty invites Pilkington and Lundberg to visit his old HQ at Kirtland Air Force Base, Alberquerque, New Mexico. Getting through security seemed a formality with Doty in charge and he then drove them several miles across the complex to Manzano mountainside where the Manzano Weapons Storage Area existed in a nuclear blast proof shelter. Nuclear weapons are stored round and about in this area. Pilkington describes being ushered along secret corridors through blast proof doors activated by palm prints until, in an inner sanctuary he describes: "Another blast proof door opens and there it is, my baby, suspended on steel cables from the ceiling; a gleaming flying saucer with a mighty dent in its side from where it fell to Earth in 1947 --- " (p229). The author suddenly cuts out and proffers no further information on this outstanding revelation. Was he gagged by the security or was it all tongue-in-cheek? Doty then says that is all he can show the guests without them getting arrested.

Away from Nevada, Pilkington delves into the history of man-made saucer shaped craft, most of which never became capable of high speed flight. He then looks into more modern systems such as Reagan's 'Star Wars' security shield.

One story that is worthy of mention involves the Roswell museum and an alien artifact supposedly. The curator of the museum, Dennis Balthasar, receives a phone call from the son of a veteran who is dying of cancer. The caller claims that his father was a former military policeman at the Roswell Army Air Base in 1947, and retained a small strip of metal from a crashed UFO. The metal is claimed to have elastic memory and immediately returns to its original shape when bent over. Balthasar understands he can collect the artifact for the museum but has to travel to Oklahoma to receive it. The date is late May, 1997, strangely close to the 50th anniversary of the Roswell crash. On arrival Dennis is surprised to find his contact has been called away on business, and he never gets to see any artifact. Eventually he meets two people at a restaurant who reveal themselves as AFOSI special agents from Dallas. They claim to have contacted the family and removed the artifact. They spend the next 3 hours rattling on about how ETs are real and expect something to happen at Roswell soon. On his return the curator tries once again to ring the contact but always seems to end up talking to AFOSI agents. Perhaps this shows a disinformation campaign was underway as late as 1997.

There is a mountain of information (or disinformation) in this book, which is generally a good read except for an excess of names, places and organisations. Probably a good part of it can be taken with a large pinch of salt! It is still not clear to me whether Pilkington is an arch-sceptic, mild sceptic or part believer in UFOs. Maybe he wants to sound just as confusing as some of the people he interviewed!

BOOK REVIEW: 'HAUNTED SKIES', The Encyclopaedia of British UFOs VOLUME 1, 1940-1959. by John Hanson and Dawn Holloway. Pub: CFZ publications. Bideford, N.Devon, EX39 5QR. pp304 ISBN: 978-1-905723-46-1

This is a long awaited book from our good friends John and Dawn, who I know have meticulously researched historical UFO cases for the best part of 20 years. They have at long last obtained a publisher who has done a tremendous job in putting HAUNTED SKIES together, particularly the work of the illustrator, David Sankey, who has had to interpret limited descriptions from these early witnesses into life-like pictures on many pages. The

quality of the material presented deserves a top publisher, but unfortunately the subject of UFOs seems to be low on the list of priorities these days. Suffice to say, CFZ publications does have a long list of Fortean subject books currently available.

Every case has been investigated with all the detail you would expect from a former CID officer - John Hanson, who served for over 27 years in the West Midlands police force until retirement in 1995. His initial plan was to produce something within a year - but 15 years later ---- Dawn assisted from the start and CIUFOR has had a number of meetings with them at Oxford and supplied further information from time to time. John often uses less conventional methods on old cases by getting the local press interested and then having a small column published appealing for witnesses to come forward. It is fair to say the authors have travelled to every corner of Britain in pursuit of their goals.

The first volume of the encyclopaedia covers the years 1940-59, so includes most of the Second World War and the austerity period afterwards. It is unclear when volume II will appear and what years it will involve. Obviously, each case is different so a reviewer can only pick out a few items of particular interest.

The period before 1947 remains a bit of a dilemma if the Roswell crash and the Kenneth Arnold experience are reckoned to be the inaugural contacts with alien beings or craft, but the very first case the authors examine concerns a landing of a metallic domed-shaped structure near Meriden, Warwickshire in the summer of 1940 with the witness describing tall humanoids with high foreheads, strange eyes and tanned skin standing around the craft.

In this early period there appears to have been very little in the way of press clippings to back up reports, but these start to emerge from 1952 onwards as shown in the text.

A number of high powered personalities are given sections of space to show their connections with the UFO subject. For instance the man who was Commander-in-Chief of Fighter command during the Battle of Britain, Lord Dowding, was highly convinced of the existence of UFOs and of life after death. The authors have managed to obtain an identification card for Dowding's use when he was apparently posted out to Washington D.C after the Battle of Britain. (p112). That other covert ufologist, Prince Philip, was known to have asked his equerry, Sir Peter Horsley, to carry out investigations on his behalf, but refused to be interviewed in 2008 when his secretary was approached by the Haunted Skies team.

One case given deserved prominence is the Bexleyheath, Kent, landing, of July 1955, witnessed by CIUFOR's Margaret Fry, amongst many others. A 25ft diameter domed disc hovered at a road junction in the middle of a residential estate in broad daylight. There could be no mistake as to what this was. (pp168-176). A memory restoring visit was made by John, Dawn and Margaret in July 2004 to the location at Bexleyheath, and with help of local newspapers more witnesses came forward.

Another important contactee who cannot be traced is Cynthia Appleton, from Aston, Birmingham. On 18th November, 1957, she claimed to have been contacted by a blonde alien while resting at home. A further encounter occurred on January 8th, 1958, and the resultant publicity was that Appleton was investigated by prominent ufologists, psychics and featured in Sunday papers and on television. (pp232-4, 237-248).

There are a limited number of heavenly bodies which are bright enough to be mistaken for UFOs. Thus 99.9% of visible stars/planets do not fall into this catagory. We consider that the planets Venus (in particular), Mars, Jupiter and occasionally, Saturn, plus the Winter star, Sirius, are the only objects worth checking for position in the sky following a night time UFO report. We can also add the Moon to this list as it sometimes is disguised by fleecy clouds giving off an odd glow.

The measure of brightness is termed 'magnitude' and is a comparison figure with the star Vega being taken as the zero figure. Stars/planets fainter than Vega will have positive magnitude and the few brighter ones show a negative value. The range of values is set out below:

MOON, magnitude -26 for the full disc.

VENUS, magnitude -4.7 to -3.5, always the brightest star-like object.

MARS, magnitude -2.9 to +1.8, only noticeable every 2 years. Distinctive red-yellow hue. JUPITER, magnitude -2.9 to +1.6, has a bright period every year. Usually high in the sky. SIRIUS, magnitude -1.4 steady and visible December-March below the constellation, Orion.

Details for 2011 are set out below:

Note that Venus starts the year as a morning spectacle towards the east, and reverts to evenings from October towards the setting Sun in the west. Mars is on the far side of the Sun in 2011 so will not become bright until the end of the year. Jupiter is bright in the evenings to start the year, but returns in May as a mainly post-midnight feature for the remainder of the year.

The dates for new moon and full moon are listed below for 2011. Skywatches are best undertaken on dark nights - say 5 days before and 5 days after a new moon.

Stop Press: The full Moon of March 19th was the largest disc seen for 19 years as the body made its closest approach to Earth. It also caused very low tides exposing sand banks not seen for many years. Did it also create massive earthquakes in Japan and New Zealand??

FEW AND FAR BETWEEN - A NEW BRITISH UFO BOOK "LINK TO THE STARS"


