

EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT TO INVESTIGATE UFO's?

On the 1st of December an official report was put before the European M.P's saying that people should not rule out the theory that aliens have established a base in the asteroid belt. The report, prepared by the Italian socialist MP and eminent physicist Tullio Regge, is being treated seriously by MEP's. He wants the Commission to set up a European UFO Observation centre to collect information about sightings reported by the public, the military and scientific institutions throughout the European Community.

Reference was made to the numerous sightings of triangular shaped UFO's that have appeared over Belgium and have been plotted moving at high speed on the radar screens of the Belgian air force. Mr Tullio Regge has also been impressed by the findings of the state-funded Service for Assessment of Atmospheric Re-entry Phenomena, based in Toulouse, France. This organisation has admitted that it cannot find a scientific explanation for 40% of the cases that it has investigated.

Mr Regge stated that "The lack, perhaps temporary or accidental, of an explanation, in no way allows us to regard sightings as certain proof or even an indication that aliens exist, with technological capabilities vastly superior to our own". "However scientists still have a duty to continue researching into these events". (extract from the report commissioned by the parliament's energy, research and technology committee).

News of the suggested UFO investigation was treated in a variety of ways by the British Press. The Daily Mail described it as a new idea for spending astronomical amounts of money. The Guardian made reference to the European Parliament more often being associated with building white elephants than seeing pink ones.

Britain's Euro MP's voted to fight the idea. Glyn Ford, deputy leader of the Labour Group, said "Europe has far more down-to-earth problems to deal with than this". In all fairness, this reflects the view recently expressed by Dr. John E. Mack (Harvard University), who speaking at the 5th Annual Ozark UFO Conference stated: "We have more to fear from the actions of our fellow-man than the Aliens".....(in the short term he is probably right! Ed.)

HUGE UFO'S ON THE MOVE AGAIN

As we go to press, news is coming in of a major "Flying Triangle" flap in the Essex area.

Ron West, who runs the Essex UFO Group is currently following up reports of triangle sightings all over the area during a three week period in November.

Ron will be sending us a complete report on the UFO events and to date he has confirmed that the objects are slow flying, silent, huge black triangular craft.

Sightings have usually taken place in the early hours of the morning 00.45am-0130am. This differs to our local sightings which took place around the 2130 period.

Ron West works closely with Timothy Good, who recently asked for details of the PRA reports. Timothy Good has sent copies of the PRA's Bakewell reports to Nick Pope of the M.O.D. It is Tim's intention to press the MOD for an answer on the widespread UFO "flying triangle" activity.

MANSFIELD UFO GROUP tell us that they have also had a report of a huge illuminated craft seen over the area on the night of 30th November. One witness made a sketch of the object and this, together with a full report, will be included in our next issue.

EMUFORA has been receiving good coverage of its activities, in the Nottingham Evening Post. The group, run by Tony James, meets regularly in the Bulwell Library.

In a newspaper report on the 12th November, details were given of the possible abduction of four teenagers in the Newstead Abbey area, earlier this year.

The four teenagers were in a car in the park, when they saw a large dark, triangular craft flying towards them. From then on, their recollections are hazy and confused.

The PRA has just received a video which includes an interview with one of the senior investigators of the "Hudson Valley" (USA) UFO flap which took place several years ago.

It seems that the area was inundated with UFO activity, including abductions. Once again, the black "triangles" were seen over the area for several weeks.

The video covering these events will be shown at a PRA meeting, probably in the new year. Watch future PRA programme information for final details.


NEW REVELATION BY "BUSTY" TAYLOR: MAGNETIC WHEAT!

The audience at the last PRA meeting were treated to a big surprise, when visiting celebrity "Busty" Taylor revealed that he had found magnetised soil and wheat stems at the scene of a Crop Circle near Yatesbury Airfield, Wiltshire, earlier this year.

Busty had featured in a lively discussion programme on BBC Radio Derby, with compère Graham Knight, before speaking at the PRA meeting on the evening of December 3rd.

Busty, who has been working in liaison with a number of American scientists during the past year, has been sending various samples to the USA for analysis. On this occasion, after sending soil and crop samples from the Yatesbury Airfield Crop Circle to the scientists, he received an urgent message to return to the circle and this time to take a magnet with him.

The only magnet available happened to be part of a loudspeaker assembly, but this served the purpose and was duly passed over the ground in the circle. When the magnet was passed over the very centre of the circle, pieces of soil, stones and wheat attached themselves to the speaker magnet (see photo below).


An extract from the PRA paper "Crop Circles: The Final Solution?" could explain the magnetic phenomenon found by Busty Taylor, it states:- "When reaching the earth, the energy field is likely to produce ground currents in the Crop Circle area and one would expect to find anomalies in any soil sample taken from the site. The effect of (DC) ground currents would be likely to induce magnetic and chemical changes although there may be some variation, depending upon the type of soil in the area."

Mike Newark, the well known dowser from Coventry, believes that UFO's are connected with the formation of Crop Circles and that the UFO's will return over the site the following year. The Charley Knoll pattern formed about the 7th of July 93 and Mike says that he would expect to see a UFO over the same site about next July.

Mike describes the Bythorn Crop Circle pattern as a "cracker" and that there were not many genuine circles this year.

CROP CIRCLE FORUM (Reviewed by - Claire Upton)

The East Midlands branch of the CCCS hosted its first Crop Circle Forum on Saturday the 4th December at the Metro Cinema Derby.

The forum was presided over by Richard Smith who started things rolling by reading out apologies from those who were unable to attend. The venue itself was excellent and the audience were seated in comfort.

Michael Green the chairman of the CCCS and Barbara Davis Secretary were guests and the forum opened with a talk given by Karen Douglas. She spoke of the esoteric side of the circles and the synchronicities connected with them and how they worked on the unconscious to bring about changes of a metaphysical and psychic nature. She also asked the audience to close their eyes and to remember where they saw their first crop circle, be it real or a photograph in a book, and to remember what it meant to them at the time.

Following this was a coffee break and then Mark Haywood took the stage. He spoke about the formation which the East Midlands group have adopted as their own "Charley Knoll and how it occurred to him, being an amateur astronomer that it represented the constellation of Cygnus the swan. He also told of how members of the study group meditated and then drew formation shapes and how these shapes appeared in the actual formation at Loughborough.

Alison Tredwell spoke next, she had the audience attempting to feel their subtle energy fields, She spoke of the "Circlemakers" and what the circles mean to her.

Lunch followed and everyone ate well and swapped stories and photographs of the past seasons' formations.

The first speaker after lunch was Andy Thomas of the Sussex Branch of the CCCS who gave a highly entertaining talk with slides on the circles in his area of Sussex. He also spoke of their attempt to communicate with the "Circlemakers" and to catch a circle in the making on video. He showed a video of a friend of theirs who is a channeller, channelling a message from a person who calls himself Joeb, this was truly amazing even if you do not believe in the phenomena of channelling it certainly makes you think.

Next to speak was John Holman Convenor of the Yorks and Humberside Branch who spoke on how the circles seemed to have a pull on him and also about his "Campaign for Alien Acknowledgement."

Last but not least a guest from the Yorks Branch Jim Lyons was persuaded to speak and he gave an interesting talk on Quantum Physics, Euclidean Geometry and the Chaos Theory. He then lightened the talk with a demonstration of dousing for subtle energies which was highly informative.


The Forum was then closed by Richard Smith and all in all an interesting day was had by all.
